Sub: Permission to Kisan Dnyanoday Mandal Homoeopathic Medical College- Maharashtra, Nimzari Road Shirpur, Dhule -425405 for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats for the academic year 2021-22 - regarding.

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy. The deficiencies observed are as under:

A. Discrepancies in engagements of teachers:

- Previous full time teaching experience of Guest Readers of Repertory department, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Forensic Medicine and toxicology, Materia Medica, Pharmacy, Organon of Medicine, Physiology, and Anatomy has not been provided in affidavit.
- Affidavit of 01 lecturer not provided instead of reader provided (Dr. Dipak Girase).

B. Hospital Staff: X-ray technician, X-ray attendant, Lab attendant, Yoga expert (names not found in attendance register and acquittance roll).

C. Miscellaneous:

- i. Biometric Attendance- document not provided.
- ii. EPF/PF /ESI deductions of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff-deducted (challan of April and May 2021 submitted 10 members)
- iii. Form-16 of teachers, non teaching staff & hospital staff-provided

D. Website – The College Website is <http://www.kdmghmc.org/> is functioning but student list not updated as checked on dated 13/10/2021.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, **Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Kisan Dnyanoday Mandal Homoeopathic Medical College- Maharashtra, Nimzari Road Shirpur, Dhule-425405 for continuing admissions in 1st BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats during the academic year 2021-22.**

All Postings/ Promotions of Regular as well as Guest and Part time teaching faculties may be made strictly as per the prevailing rules and regulations under NCH Act 2020. Principal of the College is directed to fulfil all the deficiencies within a period of 3 months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board within 7 days from issue of this Letter of Permission.

4. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. **All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly.** Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.
