Sir,

In compliance to the letter dated 09.09.2024 of Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) referred above, an affidavit has been received from the Principal/Authority of Kisan Dnyanoday Mandal's Homoeopathic Medical College, Nimzari Road, Shirpur Dist. Dhule-425 405.

The College has applied permission for sanction for BHMS course for 75 seats for the Academic Year 2024-25 through online portal. MARBH examined the profile of the college so as to assess the compliance to minimum essential standards to be fulfilled as per the regulations enforce at the time of calling applications and other provisions of NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the part -1 report following shortfalls have been observed:

**a) Teaching Departments:**

- Acquittance and Attendance register guest faculties is not uploaded.

**b) Hospital Details:**

- Attendance and Acquittance is not uploaded for consultants of modern medicine.

**c) Miscellaneous**

- College has not enabled the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance system (AEBAS). This shall be enabled within a period of one month.

IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, Phone number etc. Diagnosis shall be written as ICD-11 criteria. All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records. Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case history, analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up of patients.

Therefore, considering the above shortfalls and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue conditional permission to **Kisan Dnyanoday Mandal's Homoeopathic Medical College, Nimzari Road, Shirpur Dist. Dhule-425 405 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats for the Academic Year 2024-25.**

All deficiency noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 75 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority of State/UT Govt. as designated by Central Government/NCH for A.Y2024-25 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of the State/UT.

The category wise list of the selected candidates must be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

**Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year, if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.**

- a. The College shall submit Affidavit in the prescribed format as per Academic Council's Resolution No. 229/2013 (format attached).
- b. For those UG / PG qualifications that are not yet recognized by the Central Govt., it shall be mandatory for the College to apply to the Central council/Commission through Central Govt. and ensure that "Permitted"/"Not Recognized" qualifications are enlisted in "Recognized Qualifications", failing which University shall not grant Continuation of Affiliation to such courses from ensuing Academic Year & no student shall be admitted in such Courses.

**(v) Deficiencies observed by NCH :** The shortcomings mentioned in paragraph No. 2(a to c) and requirements as per paragraph no. 3 of NCH, New Delhi letter referred above may please be fulfilled and the compliance letter to be forwarded directly to NCH, New Delhi and copy of the same shall be forwarded to the University within a period of 30 days.

**Important Note:**

- 1) This Conditional Continuation / Extension of affiliation is issued for the A.Y. 2024-2025 subject to the permission of NCH / Govt. of India / Department of AYUSH, New Delhi. Further, if the permission is declined by the said authorities, this Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The College is not authorized to admit the students for 1st Year of the course until receipt of permission of the NCH / Govt. of India/ Department of AYUSH New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done through the Competent Authorities only.
- 3) The Conditional Continuation/Extension of affiliation is given subject to the final verdict of the Hon'ble Court/Decision by NCH/State Govt./Competent Authority w.r.t. the irregular admissions done during the A.Y. 2019-20.
